

Instructions for the maintenance with Danish oil

The maintenance with danish oil is done in five (5) steps :

- 1. Clean the surface with a neutral detergent soap and let dry 8 hours. In the event that you have grain up on your counter, use 220 grit sandpaper to make a light sanding.
- 2. Using a brush, apply a thin layer the surface with Danish oil. Let stand 20 minutes.
- 3. Using a dry, lint-free cloth, polish the surface until you have removed the excess oil and let dry for 24 hours.
- 4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 once or twice, as needed.
- 5. Do not expose to water for 48 hours.

WARNING

- Rags used for maintenance should be soaked in water before disposal because of the risk of self combustion.
- Hot containers can cause burns and delamination of the counter.
- Wet containers can cause dark circles (spots with the shape of the container). These are easy to repair ; simply repeat steps 1 to 4.
- Long-term items left on your area can create discoloration due to the fact that the oil does not filter UV rays.
